

## MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

of

## COLCHESTER HISTORICAL SOCIETY

1. The name of the Society is **Colchester Historical Society**.
2. The objects of the Society are:
  - (a) To gather, compile, and preserve written, printed and photographic documents of historic value and interest, relating to Colchester County.
  - (b) To acquire, preserve and display artifacts significant to the historic development of Colchester County.
  - (c) To gather and record stories until now unwritten, which exist only in the memory of older people.
  - (d) To administer and operate for the enlightenment, entertainment and benefit at large the Colchester Historical Society Museum, open to the public, and to select and display therein a continuing series of traveling or temporary exhibits chosen for their historical, scientific or artistic value. In addition, a permanent display area will be designated depicting the natural history of Colchester County.
  - (e) To administer and operate for the benefit of members and society at large, a research library known as the Colchester Historical Society Archives.
  - (f) To promote the marking of historic sites within Colchester County by suitable plaques, cairns or otherwise; and
  - (g) To cooperate with civic officials in civic celebrations of an historic nature.

PROVIDED that nothing herein contained shall permit the Society to carry on any trade, industry or business and the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain to any of the Members and that any surplus or any accretions of the Society shall be used solely for the purpose of the Society and the promotion of its objects.

PROVIDED, further that if for any reason the operations of the Society are terminated or wound up, or are dissolved and there remains, at that time, after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, shall be paid to some other charitable organization in Canada, having objects similar to those of the Society.

3. The activities of the Society are to be carried out principally in Colchester County, Nova Scotia.
